



Plant Care Information

Pothos (Epipremnum)

Yellow-green variegated vine with waxy leaves. Grows best in 70-90°F. Minimum temperature below 70°F or maximum temperature above 90°F will retard growth. The growing mix should be well aerated and overwatering avoided. Fertilize 19-6-12. High filtered light.

Lipstick Plant (Aeschynanthus)

Bright red, tubular flowers are produced on the cascading stems. Good growth occurs when soil temperature is 70-80°F, with similar air temperature. Soil should have excellent aeration and ample soil moisture is necessary. Fertilize 19-6-12. High filtered light.

Anthurium (*Anthurium*)

Anthuriums come in a wide variety of colors. They grow and flower best depending mostly on soil, light, and fertilizer. They require well-aerated soil mixture. Soil needs to provide sufficient moisture as well as support for the plant. Fertilizer depends on light level plant is grown in, but a 19-6-12 is sufficient. High filtered light.

Juncus (*Juncus spiralis*)

Juncus is a corkscrew grass. Two variations, green called Unicorn and variegated called Yellow Line. Likes partial or direct sunlight. Well suited for planting outside. Fertilize sparingly. Keep moist. Cannot tolerate drying out.
